

Visiting the heath

I arrive at the country hotel in the evening and receive a very warm welcome. The grounds are truly beautiful and offer everything a horse rider could wish for! The main building houses the restaurant and terrace, while the rooms are located on the upper floor and in the surrounding buildings. All have been lovingly renovated in a country house style and are, of course, very cosy with their own bathrooms. It's a place you'll want to stay!

There is also a separate wellness area with saunas, a relaxation room, etc. to unwind after riding.

The stable is right next door. It is equipped with paddock boxes, behind which are several separate pastures that guests can use for their horses (each with drinking troughs). There is a large riding arena, a round pen and a jumping arena, plus a huge meadow with some cross-country jumps and, of course, a large riding area around the farm. Here you can ride straight from the farm into the countryside without having to cross any major roads. The terrain is varied and the host can provide maps and lots of tips.

I look forward to dinner and get to try a delicious asparagus salad made with regional ingredients. The farm is located on Lower Saxony's Asparagus Route, so naturally there are several asparagus dishes on the menu at this time of year.



The next morning, I enjoy a buffet breakfast with a view of the countryside before setting off on a horse ride with my hostess: we ride across the plain, past fields, and pass a secluded lake area where you can swim with your horse. There, you can spend time with your horse, let it run free and unwind.

The versatile riding grounds also offer cross-country jumps and hunting rides are also possible here.

The terrain is varied and it's really fun to roam through nature here. I enjoy my ride in beautiful spring weather.

After our excursion through nature, we feed the horses and let them out to pasture before I sadly have to say goodbye.

If I had my own horse, I would definitely spend my holidays here! I was particularly impressed by the warmth of the hosts and the well-maintained facilities with everything a horse owner could wish for.
